A special note about air: If you have purchased only the Cruise Program, please book flights that arrive on Day 2, the first day of the Cruise Program. The date is listed at the top of your Reservation Confirmation.

Activity Level ratings indicate each excursion's physical expectations. To make the best personal choice, please evaluate each excursion's rating and your ability to meet the tour's physical demands. Excursions on this program require: walking on cobblestones, unpaved paths or uneven surfaces; and getting on/off motor coaches and boats.

- Mild – Walk under 1 mile on mainly flat terrain; navigate under 50 stairs; stand under 1 hour
- Moderate – Walk 1–3 miles on flat/uneven terrain; navigate 50–100 stairs; stand 1–2 hours
- Active – Walk 2+ miles on flat/uneven terrain, including up and down inclines; navigate 100+ stairs; stand 3+ hours

Depending on the excursion, more leisurely alternatives may be available.

Day 1 | Depart gateway city

AHI FlexAir passengers depart for Munich, Germany. Please check your luggage from your gateway city to your arrival city. Your claim checks should have the following airport code: MUC.

Day 2 Munich, Germany | Passau

Arrive at Munich Airport. Proceed through immigration to the baggage claim area and retrieve your luggage. After completing customs, AHI FlexAir passengers traveling on flights that qualify for the group arrival transfer and Cruise Program passengers who have purchased seats on the group transfer should exit the baggage claim area and proceed to the designated meeting spot, where an AHI Travel representative will meet you. The meeting location will be provided with your final documents.

Transfer to Passau, nestled at the confluence of the Danube, Ilz and Inn rivers. Picturesque Passau has been called “one of the most beautifully situated towns in the world.”

Passau Walking Tour. For passengers arriving early, embark on a walking tour of Passau and delight in the many highlights of the city, including the Gothic-style Town Hall with its beautiful clock tower. See the medieval Veste Oberhaus, perched on a hill across the river, and walk along the cobblestones of Höllgasse Artists Street, filled with numerous art galleries, shops, boutiques and more. In the heart of Old Town, step into St. Stephen's Cathedral, home of the world's largest cathedral organ boasting nearly 18,000 pipes. (Moderate)

Embark your ship, unpack and get to know your ship's amenities. The docking location of the ship will be provided in your final documents.

Captain's Welcome Reception & Dinner. Meet your fellow travelers during the Captain's festive Welcome Reception and Dinner this evening.

The ship departs tonight and starts cruising through Germany.

Day 3 | Regensburg

Regensburg is our port of call today. Once a booming merchant city, the Regensburg of today is dotted with impressive Roman ruins; Gothic, Romanesque and baroque churches; and colorful houses from the 12th and 13th centuries.

Historic Regensburg Walking Tour. Venture out on a guided walking tour of one of Germany's most charming towns. See the ancient Roman tower and gateway, Porta Praetoria; the 12th-century Stone Bridge; the bright yellow Town Hall, Altes Rathaus, which dates to the 1200s; and the enthralling St. Peter's Cathedral with its stunning stained-glass windows. Enjoy visiting the Thurn und Taxi Palace, formerly a Benedictine monastery. This ancestral home has a stunning ballroom and throne room. (Moderate)

Enrichment: Main-Danube Canal. Gather with a local expert to discuss the history, building and importance of the amazing Main-Danube Canal.

Later today, the ship enters the Main-Danube Canal, Europe's greatest man-made passageway. Spanning almost 100 miles, the canal features 16 locks, flowing from the town of Kelheim to Bamberg.

Gather with friends for a delicious dinner.

Day 4 | Nuremberg

The cityscape of Nuremberg greets you this morning! Home to Europe's first printing press, Nuremberg is often associated with expansions in science and technology. Ancient city walls from the 14th and 15th centuries lead to an array of medieval gates and towers, while the imposing twin-towered Gothic St. Lorenz church watches over the town. Lunch is served on the ship.

PYJ | Personalize Your Journey | Choose ONE of the following excursions and return the included PYJ Reservation Form with your selection by the deadline noted on the form.

- **Sights of Nuremberg.** Take a panoramic drive through the city, passing by the courthouse where the World War II trials were held. Then, begin a guided walking tour to see the city's renowned hilltop castle and courtyard and stroll down to the town center. At the Hauptmarkt, an open square dominated by the Schoener Brunnen, see the 14th-century Gothic fountain and the city's most famous attraction. View Our Lady's Church, then St. Lorenz Church, dating to the 15th century, before returning to the ship. (Moderate)
- **Documentation Center Museum Special Exhibit.** During the years leading up to World War II and through the war, Nuremberg was connected to the Nazi party. Visit a specially conceived Interim Exhibition in the Large Exhibition Hall at the Documentation Center, which presents the history of the Nazi Party Rallies and the Rally Grounds. (Moderate)

Your ship departs Nuremberg and continues through the Main-Danube Canal.

Day 5 | Bamberg | Hassfurt

Arrive in endearing Bamberg, host to an imperial cathedral and a well-preserved Old Town. Bamberg is spread across seven hills and is full of meandering cobbled lanes and authentic charm.

PYJ | Personalize Your Journey | Choose ONE of the following excursions and return the included PYJ Reservation Form with your selection by the deadline noted on the form.

- **Bamberg Walking Tour.** During a guided walking tour of Bamberg, a UNESCO World Heritage site, wander under the grand rococo archway of the Obere Brücke and enjoy the view of the red-roofed fishermen's houses and baroque mansions that highlight this fairy-tale town. (Moderate)
- **Culinary Delights.** Enjoy a culinary tour of Bamberg, where Franconian and Bavarian influences are evident. Visit a local bakery, a butcher shop, a deli and a candy store. Along the way, learn about and sample specialties such as the flaky Bamberger Hörnla, the savory Bamberger Weck and the region's famous licorice. (Moderate)

Return to the ship, now docked in Hassfurt, and begin cruising for Würzburg this afternoon. Lunch and dinner are served on board.

Day 6 | Würzburg

In this romantic region of Bavaria sits the old Franconian city of Würzburg, a village that will steal your heart with its historic architecture, vibrant Old Town and trove of magnificent churches, including the Gothic St. Mary's Chapel and the Neumünster Collegiate Church. The Old Main Bridge, the Alte Mainbrücke, is a remarkable structure lined with statues of saints.

PYJ | Personalize Your Journey | Choose ONE of the following excursions and return the included PYJ Reservation Form with your selection by the deadline noted on the form.

- Würzburg Residenz & City Walk. Visit the renowned Würzburg Residence, built between 1720 and 1744. This majestic UNESCO World Heritage site is one of Europe's finest secular Baroque palaces. Inside, the palace boasts a sumptuously decorated Imperial Hall, the Hall of Mirrors and an impressive staircase with a brilliant fresco. Afterward, enjoy a walking tour of the historic city center, passing St. Kilian's Cathedral; the Neumünsterkirche, the Old Town Hall; and the scenic market square. (Moderate – with a fair number of stairs to navigate at the residence)
- Romantic Road. Once an important trade route during the Middle Ages, the Romantic Road follows a historic path through the foothills of the German Alps and Franconia wine country. As you wind through sleepy medieval villages and quaint Bavarian towns, you'll be captivated by the half-timbered homes, fairy-tale castles and sweet alleyways decorated with colorful blooms. Then, visit Rothenburg ob der Tauber, one of Germany's best-preserved, fortified medieval towns. (Moderate)

Return to the ship and enjoy lunch on board.

Day 7 | Miltenberg

Miltenberg Walking Tour. A walking tour of romantic Miltenberg reveals traditional half-timbered houses, quaint taverns and a decorative, 16th-century octagonal fountain. See the Town Hall and Germany's oldest-working inn with its storybook facade. Visit St. Kilian Kellerei, a wine shop that sits over a 15th-century vaulted ice cellar. Today, ice is no longer stored there, but it is a charming spot for you to enjoy a tasting of Franconian brandies. (Moderate)

Culinary Experience. Gather with the crew for a one-of-a-kind lunch. Nibble, sip and socialize as you enjoy the German tradition of drinking beer accompanied by a tasty spread of Brezeln (pretzels), Weißwurst (sausages) and mustards.

The ship departs Miltenberg, cruising for Koblenz.

Day 8 | Koblenz

Cruise through one of Germany's most gorgeous areas. Make your way through the Upper Middle Rhine Valley, a particularly scenic stretch with castles and vineyards peppering the steep hills. At the narrowest point of the Rhine River, see the famous Loreley Statue, a bronze female figure steeped in legend.

Located at the confluence of the Mosel and Rhine rivers, Koblenz brims with medieval history, monuments, an imposing fortress and a handful of quirky fountains.

Koblenz Discovery. Enjoy a walk through Koblenz. More than 2,000 years ago, the Romans established a settlement at the confluence of the Mosel and Rhine rivers. Today, the beautiful town of Koblenz occupies that same strategic location. See the Town Hall; the medieval Liebfrauenkirche, the Church of Our Lady; the Alte Burg, the Old Castle; the Altes Kaufhaus, the Old Merchants' Hall; and the Deutsches Eck, the German Corner, with the monument of Emperor Wilhelm II, situated at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers. (Moderate)

Free Time: The remainder of your evening is at leisure in Koblenz. The ship overnights here.

Day 9 | Koblenz | Cochem

Depart Koblenz and sail to Cochem. After sailing through a narrow portion of the Moselle River flanked by quaint villages and tiered vineyards, the ship docks in Cochem early this afternoon.

Enrichment: Moselle Wine Tasting. Enjoy a glass of wine from the Moselle region at a nearby winery.

Cochem and the Reichsburg Castle . Take a guided walking tour of Moselle, Cochem, a city situated along a bend in the river that charms with half-timbered houses along narrow, winding streets and stepped hills draped in a tangle of grapevines, with the hilltop Reichsburg castle overlooking the town. Learn about the old town's folklore and landmarks, then tour the castle with a glass of wine from the Moselle region. Admire impressive views of the Moselle River valley from high above. Afterward, spend the remaining time exploring Cochem on your own. (Moderate)

Day 10 | Trier

Sail through the Moselle Valley, host to steep vineyards, sleepy villages and noteworthy castles.

After lunch on board, set off to discover Trier!

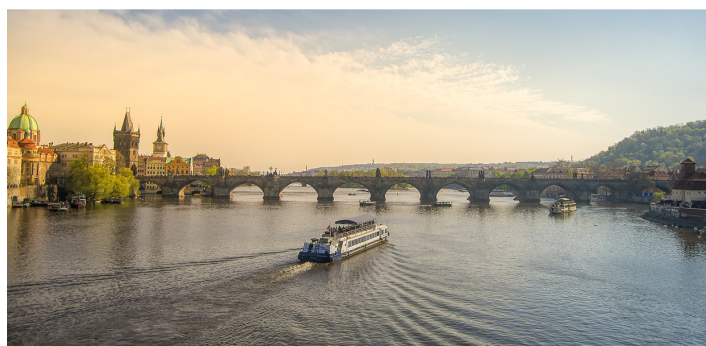
Trier. Beautiful Trier, the birthplace of revolutionary Karl Marx, features treasures of art and architecture around every turn. On a guided walking tour, follow a path through millennia while witnessing impressive masterpieces, including the Porta Nigra gate, the Cathedral of Trier, the Roman Baths and the Roman amphitheater. (Moderate)

Farewell Reception and Dinner. Share stories of your adventures with your fellow travelers at a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.
